

Hilcott Village Hall: Option 1



On this sheet, The Trustees of Hilcott Village Hall are able to demonstrate the work undertaken over the last few months drawing on the contributions made by the residents in responses to consultations.


The information displayed here is additional to that information illustrated on the recent leaflet drop and the two short animations that are referred to in the links.

The Brief for the replacement building to serve as the village hall for the present Parish of North Newnton is to provide a multi-functional building, designed and built to current expectations for accessibility, diversity and to meet future low carbon ambitions. It will be Net Zero Carbon in use. The principle accommodation will be an enlarged Main Hall with enhanced WC provision to include changing facilities and an improved and re-equipped kitchen to allow hot food service, but not full catering and secure storage of furniture and effects. All of this is to be provided within the notional existing footprint. The elevation facing the road will include village maps showing local interest in Hilcott and the wider Vale of Pewsey.

The two alternative layouts offer differing entrances and arrangements for catering and service access. Each has its own strengths, but as this is a building for the community it is wholly appropriate for the Community to contribute once more by commenting on the relative merits of each scheme and voicing a preference for any of the features and even adding ideas for further design development.

Each scheme is illustrated through a bird's-eye ground floor plan and elevation onto the road through Hilcott. Further illustrations are exterior views taken at eye-level from the road and from the adjoining field both with backgrounds of the next door house and the surrounding trees. These are to scale and are based on a Point Cloud survey. Finally, there is an interior view in both cases looking towards the new kitchen.
